

2010 INSHALLA SCRATCH LEAGUE RULES

1. U.S.G.A. rules apply, except where amended herein. Please be aware of both medal and match play rules.

All balls ***must*** be holed out

Play the ball where it lies; NO WINTER RULE

2. Cell phones must be in silent/vibrate mode. If your cell phone rings while on the course, the first occurrence of the season is a warning, each occurrence following is a 1-stroke penalty will be assessed per occurrence.

3. Each match must be played at assigned time unless a following group will take the tee in stead or your group elects to bump up to 4:20. Tee-times are from 4:30 to 5:20. ABSOLUTE

4. If you must be absent you may enlist a substitute from your flight. Substitutes should be picked from the substitute list first and then from Inshalla league rosters. The substitutes average as of that week will be used and must fit into the division average band.

5. If no substitute is available a qualifying absent player may take the average of the 4 high scores shot in that division that night. A teammate is responsible for calculating score and posting the appropriate hole-by-hole scores.

A qualifying absent player is an early season snow-bird/student/other who has given notice of start date that is ***eligible to win or loose all points***.

6. If an absent player has no substitute a player forfeit will occur. (Forfeit 2 individual points). Players who fail to find a substitute ***forfeit match and medal points***. The team of the absent player may use the high 4 average to determine total team score to compete for team points.

7. Play will be from the BLUE tee blocks, except under the following conditions:

players age 70 and over at the start of the season and women MAY choose to play white tee blocks at beginning of season; once the choice to move up is made it cannot be reversed without a league vote.

8. Each player is playing for 2 points: 1 point for medal play and 1 point for match play. Division rank based on these points.

9 Each team is playing for 3 points per match for low combined score. All team players must complete round or calculate absent player score for team to win. Team standing based on these points.

10. In the case of play termination due to weather, if more than 1/2 matches are completed the unfinished matches will be scored 1-1, and players average score

by hole will be used to complete round for team score. If 1/2 or less are completed all matches will be rescheduled.

11. New player selection process:

- 1) A waiting list will be maintained from the list of active subs with the date the player expressed interest.
- 2) As a division opening occurs, the first player on the list who fits the stroke average of that division will fill the vacant spot.

12. 2009 total strokes determine 2010 player positions.

13. Absences: if a player misses greater than three (3) matches the review committee will assess the players status for the next season.

14. Review Committee:

15. AB Eagle, CD Birdie and skins pots may be wagered for \$15 each for the season. Skins may be entered at later date prorated. Winners will be tallied each week and monies paid out at end of year banquet.

16. There will be two gimmick flags per evening. Each flag is played for an \$11.00 proshop certificate.

17. The 4:30 scheduled match each night is ***responsible*** for nightly skins sheet scoring.

18. A player may not move down (i.e. A-C) more than 1 division per year.

19. Each player is responsible for attesting scorecard promptly at end of play. The person scoring is responsible for entering scores into the league computer.

20. In lightning conditions, a player choosing not to complete a round may take hole stroke average to complete scorecard.

21. \$45.00 dues: Pays for Team and Division Shirt Awards, end of year banquet, 2 \$11 flag events per regular schedule match and scoring fee. Dues are due the first week of play. Individual points may be forfeited for unpaid dues. Team points are unaffected, and opponent points do not change.

22. Hole in ones will pay out \$150.00 (hole in one assessment cancelled) Remaining funds and other account monies will be rolled into hole in one account.
